#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health** assume costs associated with this proposal will be minimal and, therefore, absorbable, within current funding levels.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** state the proposal amends the division name. The department may promulgate rules to update its revised division name. These rules would be published in both the Missouri Register and Code of State Regulations. Approximately 148 pages could be printed in the Missouri Register to implement these changes. The rules may require approximately 99 pages in the Code of State Regulations to replace the pages affected by the name change. The estimated cost of a page in the Missouri Register is \$23. The estimated cost of a page in the Code of State Regulations is \$27. The SOS estimates a total cost of \$5,065 [(148 pgs. X \$23) + (99 pgs. X \$27)]. These costs are estimates and depend on the number of rules printed, rescinded, and amended.

**Oversight** assumes the SOS could absorb the costs of printing and distributing regulations related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require the printing and distribution of regulations at substantial costs, the SOS could request funding through the appropriation process. Any decisions to raise fees to defray costs would likely be made in subsequent fiscal years.
