#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Oversight sent response request to numerous agencies, and none have responded. In response to fiscal note 2563-01 which is similar, the following fiscal response was made.

Officials of the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department assume no fiscal impact.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal grants authority to the St. Louis Police Board, any fiscal impact would be discretionary. **Oversight** assumes this proposal as written does not create any new duties or expenditure of funds. **Oversight** assumes no state or local fiscal impact.

**Oversight** assumes that Senate Amendment 1 defines the term "reserve officer", and clarifies that a reserve officer must work within the county that they are licensed in. This amendment has made these requirements applicable to persons serving as a reserve officer on August 27, 2001 within counties of the first classification and within St. Louis County.

**Oversight** assumes that Senate Amendment 1 would have no state or local fiscal impact.
