FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the State Treasurer (STO)** state this bill adds 'eligible alternative energy operation' to the list of entities that may receive linked deposit loans. The STO states while the number of linked deposit requests generated by this new program and the resulting impact on staff workloads can not be known at this time, the STO does not currently believe that the increased workload arising from this new program by itself would warrant one full-time employee.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.
