**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Veteran's Commission** indicated there would be no fiscal impact on their agency. They contacted the Department of Defense regarding the number of potential individuals that would be eligible or have received the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal. They were advised that the Defense Manpower Data Center, the agency that archives information for the Department of Defense, does not document military members that have received or will receive the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** state that for each 100 specialty plate applications received, there will be an increase in revenue each year of \$1,500 that would be distributed as follows: Highway Fund - 75%; Cities - 15%; Counties - 10%. Costs to DOR would be \$1,509 for the first 100 specialty applications received for application, plate set-up, postage, envelopes, notification, and plate costs. The number of plates that would be requested is unknown.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation allows persons who have been awarded the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal to receive a special license plate inscribed with the words "expeditionary service" and bearing a reproduction of the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
