#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Mental Health, Department of Public Safety, Missouri State Highway Patrol, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Department of Conservation and the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions & Professional Registration each assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Department of Highways** & **Transportation** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency. These provisions are already included in federal regulations regarding sanctions for false or fraudulent claims for Title XIX services. Also, the Medicaid Physician's Provider Manual contains policy that anatomical and surgical pathology services must be performed by a physician.
