FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Department of Natural Resources** stated that under current law, counties that are subject to certain Environmental Protection Agency storm water regulations have authority to:

- 1) adopt local regulations deemed reasonably necessary to comply with the federal regulations;
 - 2) allow a storm water control utility to administer its local storm water regulations, including the imposition of a user fee; and 3) establish a storm water control utility tax, if approved.
- Officials assume no fiscal impact to DNR.

Officials of the **Little Blue Valley Sewer District** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of **Cass County Commission** assume no fiscal impact.


