FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** assume this legislation will not have a fiscal impact on their agency. This proposal will no longer require the defendant to be represented by or waive the right to an attorney in writing.

Officials from the **Department of Corrections**, **Department of Public Safety** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal will not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the State Public Defender (SPD)** state while the number of new cases (or cases with increased penalties) may be too few or uncertain to request additional funding for this specific bill, the SPD will continue to request sufficient appropriations to provide competent and effective representation in all its cases.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services (OPS)** assume the changes to Section 577.023 would not have a significant direct fiscal impact on County Prosecutors or te OPS.
