Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** state the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency, and that they already do this.

Sheriffs from **Greene County, Jackson County** as well as the Police Departments of **St. Louis County, Columbia, Kansas City** and the **St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
