FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Missouri Higher Education Loan Authority (MOHELA)** assume this will have no fiscal impact. This legislation would provide MOHELA with a level playing field in competing against student loan organizations from other states in originating student loans at a reasonable cost, enhancing the organization's long-term financial stability as well as the availability of MOHELA's low-cost student loans and generous borrower benefits to Missouri students and families. MOHELA is a public instrumentality and a body politic and corporate that has never received state appropriations.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
