FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of State Courts Administrator and Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Oversight notes the provisions of the proposal, sections 425.355 and 425.370, allow the court to impose civil penalties of up to \$1,000 per day if a debt settlement provider fails to comply with the provisions of the legislation. **Oversight** assumes minimal penalties will be collected and, therefore, is not presenting penalties in the fiscal note.
