FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** state the fiscal impact for this proposal for Administrative Rules is less than \$2,500. The SOS does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the SOS can sustain within its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the costs of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the Governor.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (DIFP)** state that at the current time there are \$19,311,868 in unused health insurance pool credits issued to HMOs and \$5,041,971 in unused health insurance pool credits issued to other pool members that could be transferred to any affiliate (total of \$24,353,839). This tax credit is taken against the General Revenue portion of premium tax. Future year's credits would depend upon the amount assessed by the Missouri Health Insurance Pool, the amount not taken by pool members and the amount transferred to an affiliate.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Budget and Planning** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact.

This proposal allows certain health insurance pool members (those not subject to the premium tax assessed under Chapter 148, RSMo) to transfer any current or unused accumulated credits or offsets to their affiliates.
