FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Department of Insurance**, and **Financial Institutions**, and **Professional Registration** stated that this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their department.

Oversight sent response request to several County Coroners and Medical Examiners and County Commissions and none have responded.

Oversight assumes that Section 67.130.1 currently requires County Coroners and Medical Examiners to attend annual training programs established by the "County Officials Training Commission" established in Section 67.130.2.

Oversight assumes under the provisions of Sections 58.095 and 58.096 RSMo. 2000, that County Coroners, Medical Examiners, and their deputies currently receive reimbursement for attending approved training courses annually. **Oversight** assumes there would be no additional fiscal impact related to the required training for Coroners and their deputies, and assistants.
