Bill Summary: Provides for the authority of a local board of education to identify a

designee to bind the school district in a settlement agreement reached during a special education resolution session; Revises §162.963, RSMo, to comply with federal law (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act); Requires school districts to disclose the total compensation packages of

school administrators; Restricts the use of dues or fees to teacher

associations for political campaign purposes without written consent of the teacher; Provides a procedure for filling a vacant school board position; Creates requirements for the educational needs of children placed in

residential care facilities.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§162.261

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume this section may result in unknown election costs to local districts.

Oversight assumes an election to fill a vacancy on the local school board would be scheduled during a regular school board election and that a special election would not be held for this single issue.

§162.961 & 162.963

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on local school districts. This proposal would bring state statutes in alignment with federal IDEA and the regulation 34 CFR 300.512(a)(3).

The following school districts stated the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their respective districts: **Marshfield, Special School District - St Louis County,** and **Independence.**

§165.111

According to officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** (**DESE**), this proposal will likely result in advertising costs and increased employee time for local school districts. DESE defers to the districts regarding total costs.

This proposal was sent to several school districts, none of which responded to a request for fiscal note. **Oversight** assumes any costs will be minimal and can be absorbed within existing resources.

The proposal also requires DESE to publish information on their Internet web site. This

requirement will increase employee work time but will not likely result in significant additional costs. **Oversight** assumes these costs can be absorbed with existing resources.

§167.128

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** state this proposal has not direct impact on the operations of the Governor's Office.

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health** assume that any costs to their agency incurred because of the provisions of this proposal will be reimbursed in accordance with §167.126.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** that this proposal either has no fiscal impact as it relates to their agency or minimal costs which can be absorbed by present appropriations.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** state this proposal has no fiscal impact on the Courts.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Division of Youth Services** state that, assuming the proposal's provision that the "family support team" and school district staff are expected to work together to create the educational plan for each student operates as intended, there would be no fiscal impact to the Division of Youth Services.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Children's Division** does not anticipate a fiscal impact on the Children's Division. Howeve; policy revisions may be necessary to clarify Family Support Team responsibilities.

§168.110 & 168.126

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state these sections will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on local school districts.

§168.295

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** (DESE) state there is no fiscal impact to their agency. DESE is unaware to what extent dues to teacher associations may currently be paid through payroll deduction; however, DESE assumes the limits imposed by this proposal will not result in significant costs to local school districts.

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ASSUMPTION (continued)

Officials from the **Independence School District** state this proposal would have a fiscal impact on their district.

Officials from the **Francis Howell School District** estimate the additional time managing the payroll deductions could cost their district an additional \$2,500 per year.

Oversight assumes administrative costs associated with this proposal could be absorbed within school district resources.
