FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Department of Natural Resources** assume no fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal, as written, is enabling legislation, and does not require certain class of counties to adopt noise ordinances. **Oversight** assumes this proposal does not provide penalties for violation of any approved ordinance, therefore; there would be no income from fines, or permit fees to offset any cost of enforcement.

Oversight assumes no state or local fiscal impact. County Commissions would have to decide to adopt, at their discretion, ordinances before local impact would be realized.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


