ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Governor's Office** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Lt. Governor's Office** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Office of the Attorney General** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Offices of the Secretary of State - Elections Division, State Treasurer, and State Auditor** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Missouri Ethics Commission** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Missouri House of Representatives and Missouri State Senate** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Platte County Board of Elections Commission** assumes if the burden of proof falls on the election authority to verify that candidates have not pled or been convicted of a felony, then the local election authority could have some costs associated with background checks and going to court to have a candidate's name removed from the ballot.

Officials of the **Sullivan County Clerk's Office** assume there could be limited fiscal impact; however, officials did not offer any explanation.

Oversight assumes that current law prohibits felons from holding office in Missouri. **Oversight** assumes this proposal strengthens and clarifies current law.

Oversight assumes local election authorities would have no new or additional duty to perform.

Oversight assumes no state or local fiscal impact.


