### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on local school districts.

Officials from the **Francis Howell School District** state their district already has an antibullying policy in place. The revision of the policy to include cyber-bullying and electronic communications would not have a fiscal impact on their district.

Officials from the **Marshfield**, **Poplar Bluff**, and **Sikeston School Districts** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective districts.

In response to identical legislation from last session (SB 762 - FN 3104-01), officials from the **Farmington** and **Independence School Districts** assumed no fiscal impact.
