#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Department of Social Services** assume no fiscal impact to the department.

Officials of the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume no fiscal impact.

In Response to a similar proposal in 2008, SB 897, fiscal note 3856-01, officials of the **St. Louis** County Recorder of Deeds Office stated that based on prior year statistics, they would estimate the increase in the recording fee from \$3 to \$10 would generate in 2009 approximately \$500,000, (this was calculated by the estimated number of recordings for the last quarter of the year if the bill were passed in August 2008.); and officials estimate revenues generated in 2010 at \$2,000,000; and \$2,000,000 in 2011.

Officials stated there would be no fiscal impact or administrative impact to their office operations.

Officials of the St. Louis County Department of Human Services assume this proposal would have no administrative impact from administering the additional revenues generated by this proposal.

**Oversight** assumes the fee increases provided for in this proposal would require voter approval. Oversight will show fiscal impact as \$0 or the amount estimated by the County Recorder of Deeds.

# FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
