FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue**, **Missouri Southern State University**, and **Missouri State University** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

In response to a previous version of the proposal (SCS for HB 239, LR # 0752-04), officials from the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions, and Professional Registration, University of Missouri, University of Central Missouri, Metropolitan Community College of Kansas City, and Northwest Missouri State University assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed within existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

In response to a previous version of the proposal (SCS for HB 239, LR # 0752-04), officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** assumed many bills considered by the General Assembly include provisions allowing or requiring agencies to submit rules and regulations to implement the act. The SOS is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of normal activity resulting from each year's legislative session. The fiscal impact for this proposal for Administrative Rules is less than \$2,500. The SOS recognizes this is a small amount and does not expect additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the SOS can sustain with their core budget. Any additional required funding would be handled through the budget process.
