FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Metropolitan Community College, Missouri Southern State University, Missouri State University, Linn State Technical College, Truman State University, Moberly Area Community College, Missouri Senate, University of Central Missouri, Missouri Western State University, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Missouri Department of Conservation, Missouri Department of Transportation, Department of Revenue** and the **Lincoln University** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education** assume that it could perform this additional duty without the appropriation of additional funds or FTE.

In response to the previous version of this bill, officials at the **University of Missouri** assume this would cost \$1,255,000 due to additional administrative costs to implement the legislation as well as lost revenue from distant education and dual credit students.

Oversight assumes that the costs associated with this proposal will be paid out of the College or Universities' normal operating expenses and that there is no fiscal impact to General Revenue. Additionally, Oversight assumes that the Colleges and Universities will raise their fees to cover the costs of the additional requirements outlined in this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

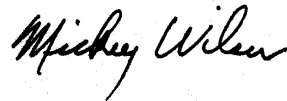
FISCAL DESCRIPTION
