ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Department of Mental Health, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, Missouri Department of Transportation, and Missouri Department of Conservation assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **DPS** - **Missouri State Highway Patrol (MHP)** defer to the Missouri Department of Transportation for response regarding the potential fiscal impact of this proposal on their organization.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DOS)** state based on MO HealthNet Division's (MHD) response, the requirements of this proposal are already included in 13 CSR 70-3.030(3)(a)26, Sanctions for False or Fraudulent claims for Title XIX Services. Also, current policy in the Medicaid Physicians' Provider Manual requires anatomical and surgical pathology services to be performed by a physician. Therefore, this proposal will have no fiscal impact on the DOS or MHD.
