ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture** assume no fiscal impact to their agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Conservation (MDC)** assume this proposal would not have significant fiscal impact on MDC funds. The Conservation Commission's Wildlife code of Missouri currently requires persons possessing Class II wildlife shall comply with all requirements of section 578.023, RSMo.

Officials from **Cass County** assume there may be a fiscal impact on this proposal however they assume that if a registration fee is used that local governments may recoup costs for registering, tracking animals, and enforcing the proposal.

Officials from **Clinton County** and **Cass County** assume revenues may go up if a license is needed.
