ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume there will be no fiscal impact to their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Mental (DMH)** assume this proposal would establish a payment of \$15,000 annually to the county counselor for duties relating to mental health for certain counties (first class county with more than 135,000 but less than 135,500 inhabitants) and an additional \$15,000 annually for investigative and clerical costs.

The **Department of Mental Health** assumes that one county (Boone) is intended in this proposal, therefore an annual cost of \$30,000 is projected.

Officials from **Boone County** did not respond to our request for a fiscal impact from their county.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Under this act, the county counselor of Boone County shall receive \$15,000, payable by the state, for duties relating to mental health and mental health facilities and an additional amount not to exceed \$15,000 for investigative and clerical personnel assisting with such duties.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
