## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development - Public Service Commission (PSC)** and **Office of Public Counsel** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective divisions.

**Oversight** assumes that potential savings due to a reduction in the number of rate proceedings would be offset by the requirement that the PSC must review the cost portion of net write-offs as reflected in purchased gas adjustment rates once each year.

Officials from the **City of Centralia** estimate no fiscal impact to their city, based on historical data.

Officials from **Cass County** assumed no fiscal impact on local funds resulting from proposed legislation.

**This proposal was sent to several other cities and counties who did not respond to a request for fiscal note.**


