FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the Administrative Hearing Commission, Department of Higher Education, Missouri Western State University, Office of Administration, Budget and Planning, Office of the State Treasurer, Office of the Governor and the Lincoln University assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **University of Central Missouri** assume \$2 million in savings if this funding for the Morrison-Garrison complex is continued.

Officials at the **Missouri Southern State University** assume a minimal fiscal impact if the state of Missouri receives part of the stimulus package. If the state removes the funding of the University then the University will lose millions.

Officials at the **University of Missouri** assume revenue of \$78,271,228 to complete construction on the projects of which 42,446,772 has already been spent if this proposal is adopted.

Oversight assumes this proposal is urging the Governor to deposit any federal stimulus money in the Lewis and Clark Discovery Fund.
