### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency. DMH currently contracts with certain counties to provide confinement for persons detained as sexually violent predators. This proposal would clarify and codify these arrangements.

**Oversight** assumes no local fiscal impact, as Department of Mental Health currently contracts with certain counties to provide confinement for persons detained as sexually violent predators, and the proposal clarifies and codifies these arrangements.

Officials from the Office of the Secretary of State, Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Jackson County Sheriff's Department, Platte County Sheriff's Department, and the St. Louis County Police Department did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.
