FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 208.192:

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Missouri Senate**, **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** each assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)** state the DMH already submits data to the federal Medicaid Statistical Information System, therefore, this proposed legislation poses no additional fiscal impact.

In response to a previous version of this proposal, officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** assume the proposed legislation requires the MO HealthNet Division (MHD) to implement a program to make information on individuals collected under the federal Medicaid Statistical Information System (MSIS) available through its Internet web site by August 28, 2010. This information must be de-identified in accordance with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, as amended. The fiscal impact is \$4,000,000.

Oversight assumes there will be a fiscal impact to the Department. However, Oversight believes the fiscal impact is unknown.

Section 208.955 in response to a similar proposal from this year (SB170):

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, **Department of Mental Health** and the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions & Professional Registration** each assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** states based on historical cost of expenses reimbursed to committee members, the annual cost per member is \$175. The cost for the additional eleven members would be \$1,925 annually. Since this is a minimal amount and assuming existing FY2009 core funding levels, the MHD will absorb the cost; therefore, there is no fiscal impact.

<u>ASSUMPTION</u> (continued)

Sections 191.1127 & 191.1130:

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** assume since this section will require the MO HealthNet Division to examine and improve hospital discharge and follow-up procedures and to establish on-going quality improvement for newborns there will be a fiscal impact however the cost is unknown at this time.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** have not responded to Oversight's request for fiscal information.

Oversight assumes since the legislation requires the Department of Health and Senior Services to prepare written educational publications regarding premature newborns that the Department will see a fiscal impact. However, Oversight does not know what this impact will be. Therefore, for fiscal note purposes only, Oversight assumes an unknown impact at this time.
