ASSUMPTION

Officials at the Department of Higher Education, Missouri Southern State University, Linn State Technical College, Missouri Western State University, Missouri State University, University of Central Missouri, Lincoln University and the Metropolitan Community College assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **University of Missouri** assume some additional administrative costs for implementation and record keeping however, the cost is unknown as the number of students is unknown.

Oversight assumes this proposal would not fiscally impact state revenue as the costs to the Colleges to administer the repeat courses would be absorbed with existing resources or offset by the tuition paid by the students.
