FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education (DHE)** assume this proposal would have no direct, foreseeable fiscal impact on DHE.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency. School districts could see possible savings if they participate in the cooperative actions outlined in the proposal.

Officials from **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the Columbia Police Department, Boone County Sheriff's Department, and the St Louis County Police Department state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective departments.

Officials from the **Metropolitan Community College of Kansas City** state this proposed legislation would have a positive, although unknown, fiscal impact on the Metropolitan Community College.

Officials from **Linn State Technical College** assume this proposal could result in potential savings if a large purchasing consortium were established, but it would be difficult to determine the amount of savings.

Officials from the **University of Missouri** do not anticipate a negative fiscal impact. Joining with other entities to share services should reduce overall costs. The amounts would be difficult to estimate.

Officials from **Missouri State University** (**MSU**) state savings may eventually be anticipated if opportunities present themselves for such efficiencies. MSU assumes any projected savings would be speculative at this time. MSU further notes that may public entities are already having discussions as outlined in the proposed legislation in an effort to increase efficiency and save money. There may be some minimal administrative costs required to implement the proposal.

Officials from Missouri Southern State University assume an indeterminate fiscal impact.

Officials from Northwest Missouri State University, Missouri Western State University and

St Louis Community College assume no fiscal impact associated with this proposal.

Officials from the **Parkway Public School District** state this proposal would have no cost to their district and could result in substantial savings in the future.

Officials from the City of Richmond responded to a request for fiscal note response, but gave no indication of fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive and therefore, for fiscal note purposes only, will assign no fiscal impact.
