FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Corrections - Missouri Vocational Enterprises** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** concur with the response from the Department of Revenue.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** provided the following estimate of fiscal impact:

Administrative Impact - Motor Vehicle Bureau

- Procedures will need to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours of overtime at a cost of \$805 in FY 12.
- The Application for Missouri Personalized and Specialty License Plates (DOR-1716) will need to be revised to include a new plate type. This will require 40 hours of overtime for a Management Analyst Specialist I, at a cost of \$805 in FY 12.
- The DOR web site will need to be updated to include the new plate type. This will require 10 hours of overtime for an Administrative Analyst III, at a cost of \$218 in FY 12.

Total cost for FTE in FY 12: \$1,828

Set-up cost

• DOR is charged \$250 for the initial set-up of a new specialty plate for passenger, truck, and RV as well as an additional charge of \$90 each to include disabled and motorcycle plates, for a total of \$430 for the initial set-up. This is a one-time fee.

Plate manufacturing cost:

- Currently, it costs DOR \$4.25 per plate (\$8.50 per set of plates) for manufacturing flat plates through Missouri Vocational Enterprises.
- The number of applicants who will wish to obtain this plate is unknown. DOR is assuming 200 applicants in FY 12 at a cost of \$1,417 in FY 12.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. **Oversight** assumes DOR could absorb the personal service costs and other costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DOR could request funding through the appropriation process.

<u>Information Technology - OA-ITSD (DOR):</u>

The Title and Registration Intranet Processing System (TRIPS) plate table would need to be updated to reflect the "Don't Tread on Me" plate.

Revenue Impact

As written, DOR will not see a revenue impact as there are no fees associated with the issuance of this license plate.
