ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture, Office of Administration, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Missouri Department of Transportation, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, Missouri Ethics Commission, Office of Prosecution Services, City of Kansas City, City of Raytown, City of Richmond and Parkway School District** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **City of Springfield** state they are unable to determine the fiscal impact of this legislation as they believe the bill covers the entire state code.

Due to time constraints, the following agencies were unable to respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact: **Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Economic Development, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Corrections, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Revenue, Office of Secretary of State, Office of State Treasurer, and various Cities, Counties, St. Louis County Fire District, Schools, and Water Districts.** Oversight assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact on these organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
