# **ASSUMPTION**

#### Section 338.330:

Officials from the Department of Public Safety, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Social Services, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration and the Department of Mental Health each assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri State Highway Patrol** (MSHP) states the Department of Highways and Transportation (DHT) will be responding on behalf of the MSHP.

Oversight notes that the DHT did not respond on behalf of MSHP and assume no fiscal impact.
