ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions**, and **Professional Registration** and **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)** state the DMH currently has policies, procedures and staffing in place that meet the requirements of this proposed legislation. Therefore, this proposal has no fiscal impact on the DMH.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services (DSS) - MO Health Net Division** state this legislation would require MO HealthNet to update and verify the accuracy of the information on its website at least twice annually. There would not be a fiscal impact to MO HealthNet.
