FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Children's Division** state this bill adds the condition that a biological parent of an adopted adult who is 100 years or older at the time of the request, to the conditions in which identifying information about the biological parent of an adopted adult may be released without consent.

This bill also specifies that if the identifying information of an adopted adult is disclosed under subsection 7, identifying information about an adult sibling shall be released only if consent is given by the adult sibling.

The Children's Division does not anticipate that the release of identifying information of biological parents of adopted adults represent a large number. The Division does not anticipate a fiscal impact as a result of this legislation.
