#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** responded that this proposal would have no direct foreseeable fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **University of Missouri** state this proposal has no fiscal impact on the University. No costs are associated with the proposal at this time because the program has not received funding since 2004. The increase requested in the maximum grant limit is to compensate for inflation since that time and insure that the grants can support the increased cost of the studies if and when funding is restored.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal increases the amount of the grant that the University of Missouri may distribute to a recipient. Therefore, this proposal does not have a fiscal impact.
