FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** and **Department of Revenue** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

In response to a similar bill, HB 1106, officials from the **Counties of Buchanan, Johnson** and **Lawrence** assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their local governments.

Oversight assumes this proposal outlines qualifications and therefore would have no fiscal impact on state or local governments.

Officials from the **Counties of Andrew, Bates, Miller** and **Scott** did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
