FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on school districts.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** assume there should be no added cost to the Governor's Office as a result of this proposed legislation.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** state this proposal either has no fiscal impact as it relates to their agency or minimal costs which can be absorbed by present appropriations.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** indicated no fiscal impact resulting from this proposal.

In response to an identical proposal (HB 1174 - FN 4621-01), officials from the **Malta Bend School District** stated this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their school district.

This proposal was sent to Unaccredited and other Provisionally Accredited school districts who did not respond to a request for fiscal impact: Calhoun, Caruthersville, Kansas City, Gilliam, Hayti, Jennings, Morgan County, Normandy, Riverview Gardens, Malta Bend, St Louis City, Swedeborg.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
