FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume there is no fiscal impact at this time.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Budget & Planning (OA)** assume these are MoDOT parcels, and the proposal is intended as a clean-up which shifts title from the State to the Highway Commission.

MoDOT may sell the properties in the future, but the value is unknown at this time. OA defers to MoDOT for an estimate of any potential revenue.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
