FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Missouri Gaming Commission (GAM)** assume this proposal changes how often a casino or an individual is required to file an application for licensure with GAM.

GAM state this proposal does not modify the requirement of an annual renewal fee being charged by GAM to maintain an operator license. GAM assumes this proposal has no fiscal impact on the operations of GAM.

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** and **St. Louis County** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation.

In response to an identical version, LR 4758-01, SB 580 (2012). Officials at the **City of St. Louis**, **City of Maryland Heights**, and **Buchanan County** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation.

Oversight assumes this proposal changes the license renewal period for gambling boat operators from two years to every five years, but maintains the current assessed annual fee.

Oversight assumes this proposal changes the licensing renewal period from every year to every two years for certain occupations within excursion gambling boat operations, but maintains the current assessed annual fee.

Oversight assumes there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation on state or local government funds.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
