ASSUMPTION

In response to a previous version of this legislation, officials from the **Department of Natural** Resources, Department of Corrections, Missouri State Employees Retirement System, Office of the Governor, Office of Administration - Budget and Planning, Department of Revenue, Department of Mental Health, Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, Department of Social Services, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, Department of Transportation, Office of the State Courts Administrator, Missouri House of Representatives, Missouri Veterans Commission, Department of Higher Education, Missouri Department of Conservation, Administrative Hearing Commission, Department of Economic Development, Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Emergency Management Agency, Office of the Secretary of State, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Missouri Ethics Commission, Department of Transportation and Patrol Employees Retirement System, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, Department of Public Safety - Capitol Police, Office of the State Auditor, Department of Agriculture, Missouri Senate, Missouri Lottery Commission, Department of Public Safety - Division of Fire Safety, Office of Prosecution Services, Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement, Office of the State Public Defender, State Tax Commission, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Office of the State Treasurer, Missouri Gaming Commission, Department of Public Safety -Alcohol and Tobacco Control, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education each assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

In response to a previous version of this legislation, officials from the **Office of Administration** - **Budget and Planning (BAP)** stated that the **Office of Administration** - **Division of Personnel** (**OA** - **DOP**) currently prepares a monthly staffing headcount report. BAP defers to OA - DOP for fiscal impact.

Officials from the Attorney General's Office, Bi-State Development Agency, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Corrections, Office of the Governor, Missouri Lieutenant Governor, Missouri National Guard, Missouri State Employees Retirement System and Office of Administration - Information Technology Services Division did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.
