## **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Jefferson City Police Department (JCPD)** state fiscal impact does occur whenever dogs involved in the crime of dog fighting are kenneled. JCPD assumes local law enforcement that currently operate an animal shelter or animal control function would be required to do this now.

JCPD assumes this proposal provides government owned shelters guidelines and some liability protection in these instances.

JCPD assumes no additional fiscal impact as a result of this proposal.

Officials at the Department of Agriculture, Department of Health and Senior Services, Missouri State Highway Patrol, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, and Office of State Courts Administrator each assumes there is no fiscal impact from this proposed legislation.

**Oversight** assumes there is no additional fiscal impact from this proposed legislation on state or local government funds.
