FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state that, until the make up of the council is determined, they cannot estimate costs; however, they do not anticipate significant costs.

Officials from Linn State Technical College and the Kansas City Metropolitan Community College indicated an unknown fiscal impact on their respective institutions.

Oversight assumes any fiscal impact to community colleges would only relate to participation on the advisory council which would be minimal and could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the Department of Higher Education, Office of the Governor, Missouri Senate, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Northwest Missouri State University, Missouri State University, and the University of Central Missouri each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Due to time constraints, responses were not received from the **Department of Economic Development - Division of Workplace Development** and **Southeast Missouri State University**. The proposal relates to their participation on the advisory council and Oversight assumes any costs associated with such participation would be minimal.
