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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** and the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** each assume there is no fiscal impact to their organization from this proposal.

Officials at the **Kansas City Board of Election Commission** assume in order to conduct two elections (March and April) one month apart, additional temporaries and staff overtime would be needed. Also, additional rent of election machines would be needed. The cost is estimated to be \$50,000.

Officials at **Buchanan County** assume this would have an unknown impact on the County.

Officials at the following board of election commissions: St. Louis City Board of Election Commission, Clay County Board of Election Commission, Jackson County Board of Election Commission and St. Louis County Board of Election Commission did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Officials at the following counties: Andrew, Audrain, Barry, Bates, Boone, Callaway, Camden, Cape Girardeau, Carroll, Cass, Clay, Cole, Cooper, DeKalb, Franklin, Greene, Holt, Jackson, Jefferson, Johnson, Knox, Laclede, Lawrence, Lincoln, Marion, Miller, Moniteau, Monroe, Montgomery, New Madrid, Nodaway, Ozark, Perry, Pettis, Phelps, Platte, Pulaski, Scott, St. Charles, St. Louis, St. Francois, Taney, Warren, Wayne and Worth did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes that changing the date of the presidential primary election would not affect the cost of the election. Oversight assumes no impact from this provision.
