ASSUMPTION

§ 21.750 - Open carrying of firearms:

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol**, **Office of State Courts Administrator**, **Office of Prosecution Services**, **City of Kansas City**, **City of Columbia**, **Columbia Police Department**, and **Boone County Sheriff** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes this proposal repeals the authority of political subdivisions to regulate the open carrying of firearms. The proposal is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on state or local government funds.

Officials from numerous cities and counties did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
