FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§ 50.622 - County Budgets:

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State, Office of the State Auditor, and Missouri Tax Commission** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from **St. Louis County** assume an unknown but minimal impact on the county.

Oversight assumes this proposal is enabling legislation that allows counties to amend their budgets to reflect decreases in revenues no more than twice each fiscal year when faced with an unanticipated decline in revenue. Therefore, **Oversight** assumes no direct fiscal impact on state or local government funds.

Officials from numerous counties did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
