FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and **Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue - Motor Vehicle Bureau (MVB)** state that procedures will need to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours of overtime at a cost of \$1,206 in FY 14. In addition, the department's website will need to be updated. This will require 10 hours of overtime for an Administrative Analyst III, at a cost of \$325 in FY 14.

Oversight assumes Department of Revenue (DOR) is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity with regard to procedure and website changes, each year. Oversight DOR assumes could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DOR could request funding through the appropriation process.
