ASSUMPTION

§ 571.067 - Firearm Exchange Program:

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol**, **City of Kansas City**, and the **City of Columbia** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes should any county, municipality, or governing body offer a firearms exchange program the firearms collected would be sold or traded to any interested licensed firearm dealer with the proceeds of the sale belonging to the county, municipality, or governing body.

Oversight assumes no direct fiscal impact or an unknown positive fiscal impact if a county, municipality, or other governing body has a firearms exchange program.

Officials from numerous cities and counties did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Direct fiscal impact to small business licensed firearm dealers would be expected from this proposal if a county, municipality, or other governing body has a firearms exchange program.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

§ 571.067 - Firearm Exchange Program:

This proposal prohibits a county, municipality, or other governmental body from participating in a program in which individuals are given a thing of value in exchange for surrendering a firearm unless the county, municipality or governmental body adopts an ordinance providing that any firearm received will be offered for sale or trade to a licensed firearms dealer.

The proceeds from the sale must be deposited with the county, municipality, or governmental body unless the proceeds are collected by a sheriff, in which case they must be deposited in the County Sheriff's Revolving Fund. If the firearm is not sold or traded after being offered to at least two licensed firearms dealers, then the county, municipality, or governmental body may destroy the firearm.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
