## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

#### § 60.570 - Land Survey Program Headquarters:

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources (DNR)** state the proposal does not indicate any requirement to add signage to the building and would not anticipate a direct fiscal impact from this proposal

DNR assumes if the intent is to require some type of signage, there would be an unknown indirect costs for that signage.

**Oversight** assumes DNR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. **Oversight** assumes DNR could absorb any costs related to this proposal.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Facilities Management Design and Construction** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
