ASSUMPTION

§ 82.485 - St. Louis City parking enforcement division:

In response to similar legislation from 2013 (HB 656), officials from **St. Louis City (STL)** stated the Parking Enforcement Division and Parking Meter Division currently operate as one division. This proposal changes existing statute to match the current practice of STL.

STL assumed this proposal would have no fiscal impact on the city.

Oversight assumes this proposal will have no direct fiscal impact on state or local government funds.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.
