FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education (DHE)** assume no fiscal impact since the programs administered by DHE are already using the definitions contained in the Access Missouri program. Additionally, the definitions are not substantively different.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans Commission**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri National Guard**, and **Legislative Research** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

The following colleges and universities indicated no direct fiscal impact to their respective institutions as a result of this proposed legislation: Lincoln University, Missouri Western University, University of Central Missouri, University of Missouri System, Missouri Southern State University, Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Linn State Technical University.

Officials from the following colleges and universities: Crowder, East Central Community College, Harris-Stowe, Jefferson College, Kansas City Metro Community College, Moberly Area Community College, Southeast Missouri State University, State Fair Community College, St. Charles Community College, St. Louis Community College, Three Rivers Community College, and Truman State University, did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
