FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of Administration** assume this proposed change would result in unknown costs to the State Legal Expense Fund.

Officials at the **Office of the Attorney General (AGO)** assume this proposal potentially expands the types of entities and activities covered by the State Legal Expense Fund (LEF). The AGO is responsible for the legal defense of the LEF. The AGO assumes that costs associated with the proposal could be absorbed with existing resources, but may seek additional resources if significant additional litigation results.

Oversight assumes that since AGO administers the State Legal Expense Fund, they will not ask for any additional funding that is specific to this proposal.

Officials at the **Department of Social Services** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.
